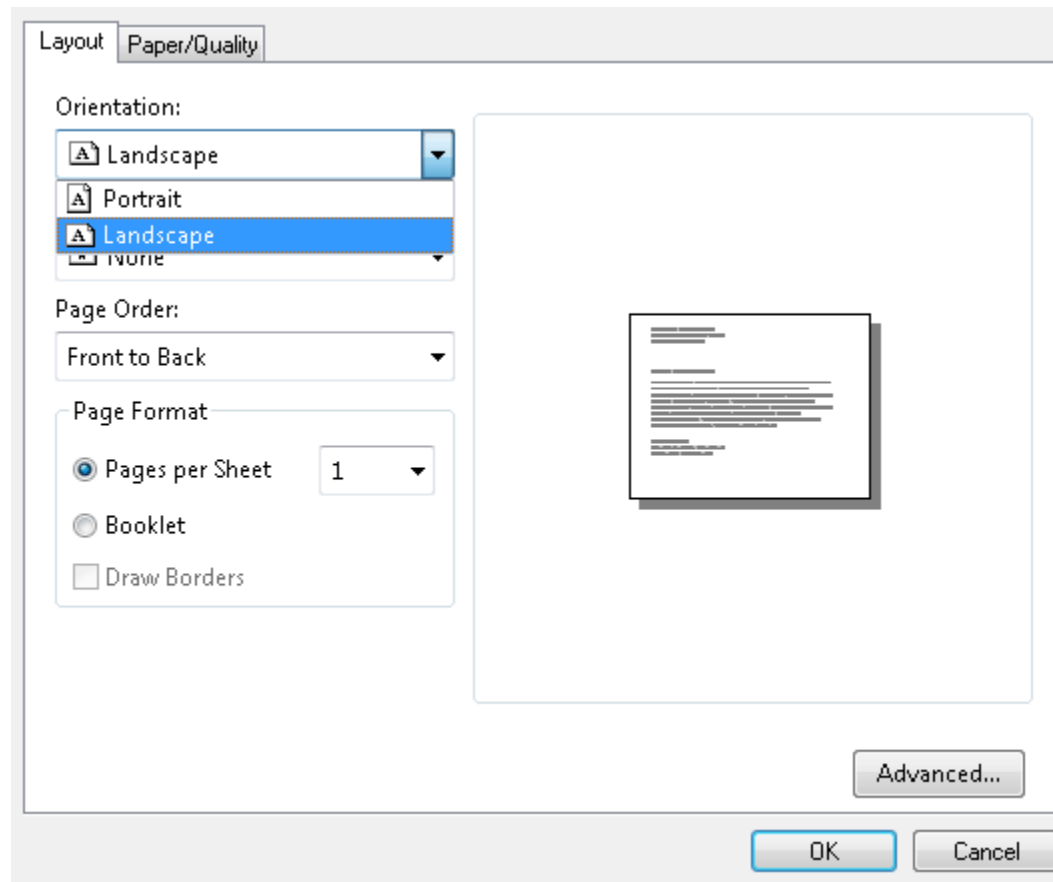

When you choose to print, make sure to choose “landscape” mode.

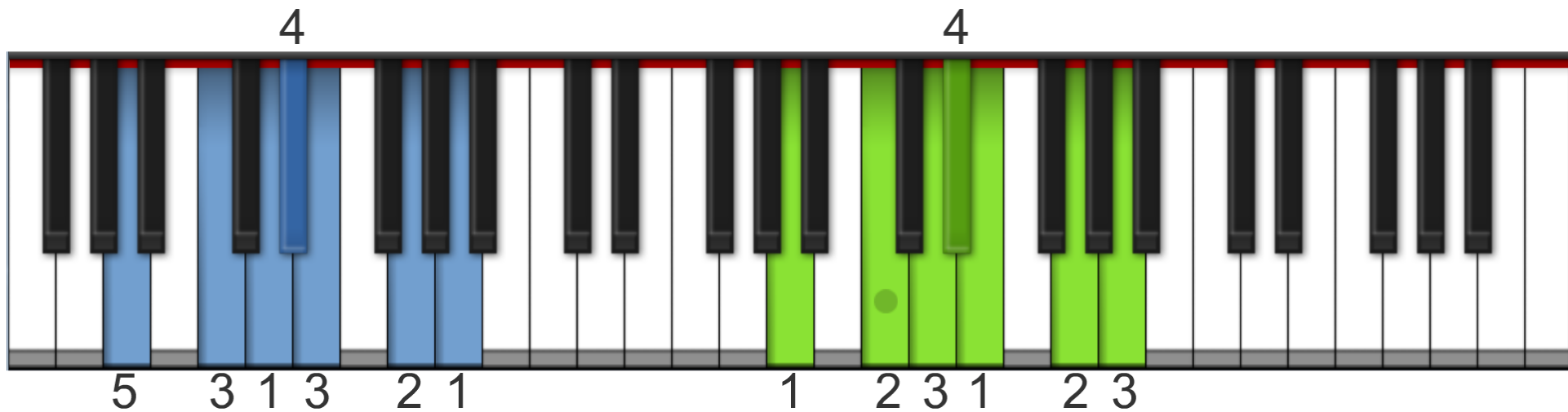
When printing, you'll usually see something similar to the picture below (Depending on your setup, you may have to choose “print” and then “properties”)



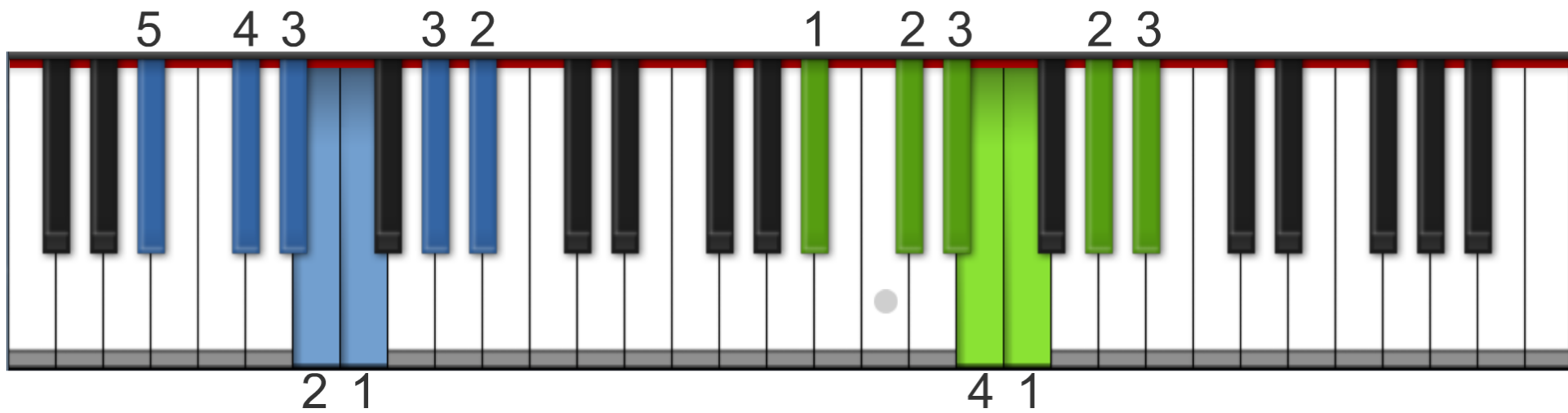

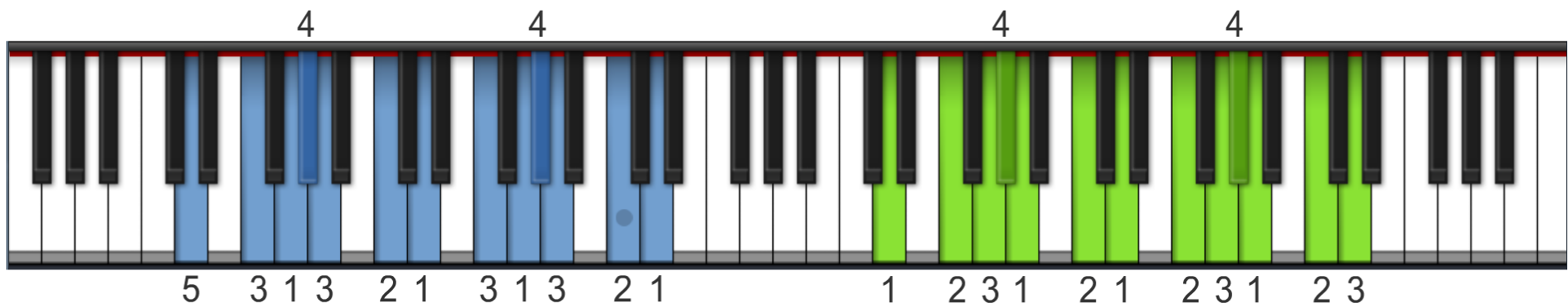

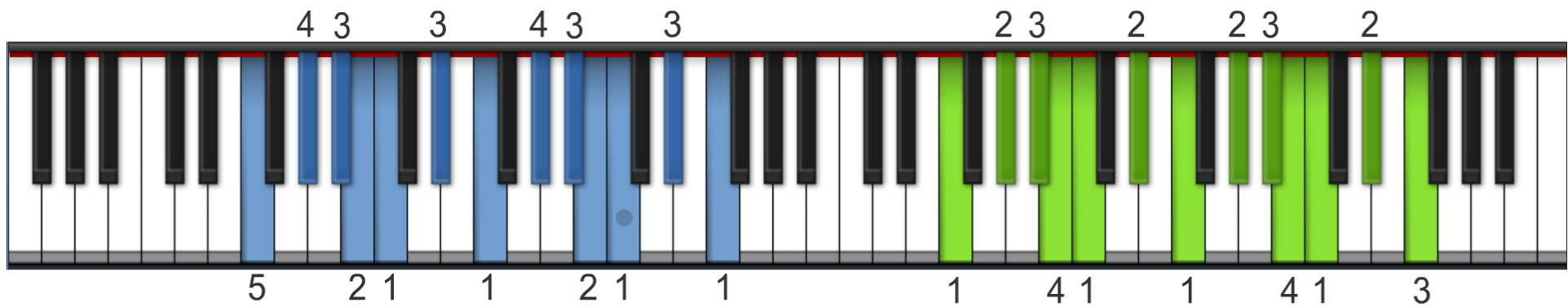

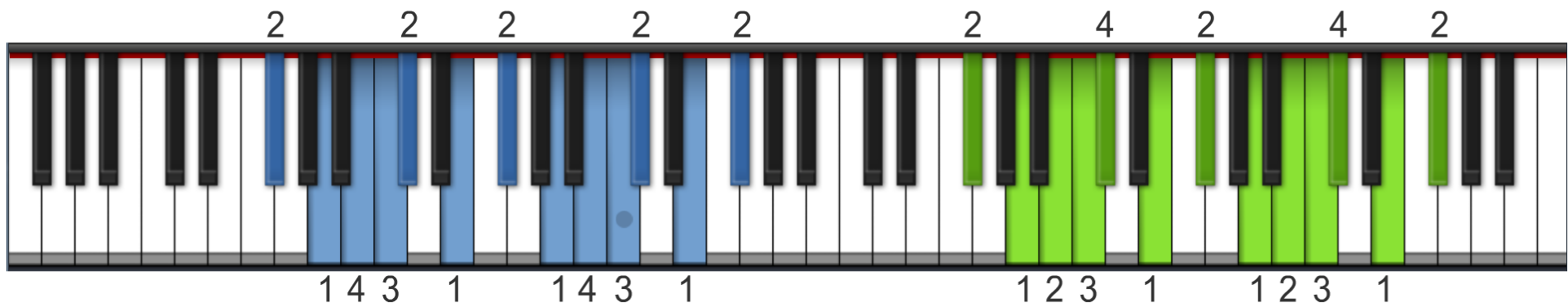
